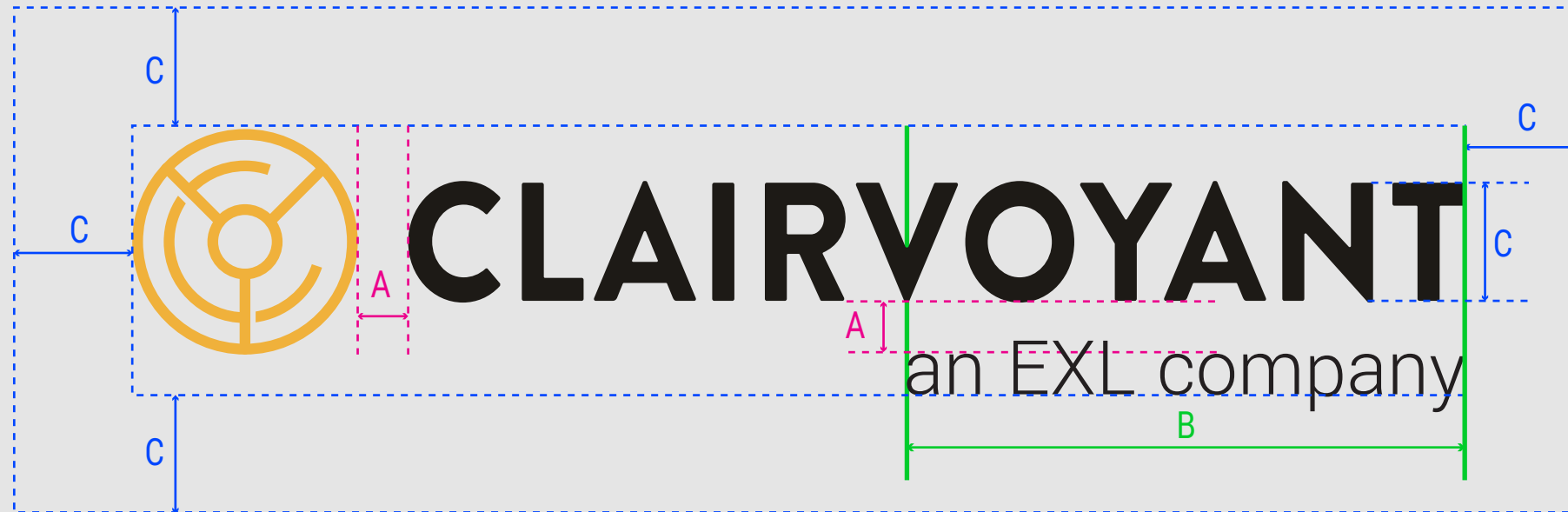


Logo lockup spacing/proportions



Logo file formats

RGB

Red, Green, Blue files are to be used for digital applications, such as web, email, presentations, or anything that is device-reliant.

RGB files use primary colors of light displayed through a digital device or display and are typically more vibrant.



RGB - 251, 78, 11



RGB - 0, 78, 255

CMYK

Cyan, Magenta, Yellow, Black files are for print applications such as booklets, magazines, and documents.

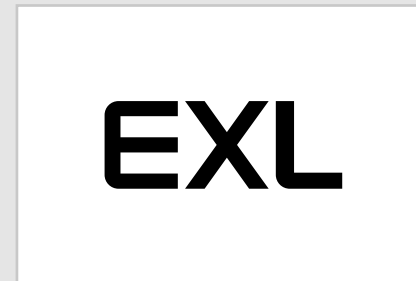
CMYK files use the primary colors of pigment. They are reflective in nature, and muted in color.



CMYK - 0, 80, 98, 0

TRANSPARENCY

.jpg

High compression raster files that do not have transparency and have a white background by default.



TRANSPARENCY

.png

Little or no compression raster files that have transparency. These RGB files are best used for web/digital applications, and MS Office apps.



.eps

Vector files used for highest quality reproduction in offset and digital printing. Most product and print vendors require this file format.
